BAND ADJUSTMENTS

Low and Reverse bands are adjusted with the same procedure. These adjustments must be done carefully since it is not possible to readjust after the transmission is installed in the vehicle.

- 1. Loosen the lock nut and turn the adjusting screw clockwise until considerable resistance is felt, indicating the band is in full contact with the drum or ring gear.
- 2. Back off the adjusting screw until a trace of play can be felt by prying up on the lock nut with a screw driver.
- 3. Back off the adjusting screw six complete turns and snug up the lock nut.
- 4. Note the position of the adjusting screw, and tighten the lock nut to 20-25 foot pounds of torque, making sure the adjusting screw does not turn.
